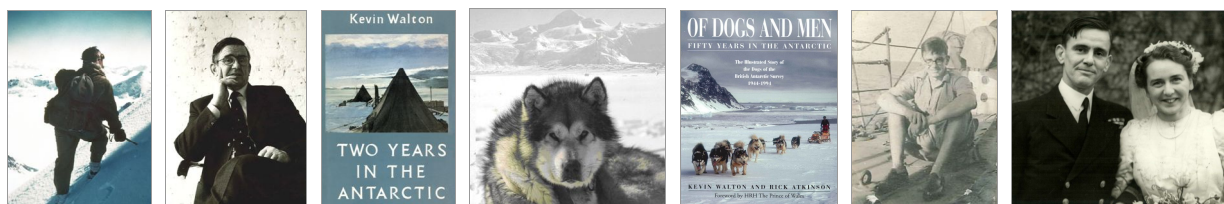

HUSKIES! This is the dominant theme of a gathering which is being held as a memorial to Kevin Walton, almost exactly a year after his death and to which you are warmly invited.

There will be a brief presentation and summary of Kevin's life by various friends and family. This will be followed by a 3-way presentation about the history and use of Huskies by the British in Antarctica. This will be by 3 FIDS, not just with experience in driving huskies but also professionally experienced in Husky physiology.

Finally there will be a presentation of Kevin's medals to the Scott Polar Research Institute in the presence of members of the VC / GC Association. SPRI have agreed that these medals will be included in the permanent medal display in their newly refurbished Museum. The museum will be in the final stages of the refurbishment by Mid-April and guests on this occasion may be allowed a preview of the new facility. The formal proceedings will last until approx 3.30pm, this will be followed by 'Tea, coffee and 'sticky buns'.

TRAVEL and PARKING. This is Not Easy! The Chemistry department shares an entrance off Lensfield Road with the SPRI – they allow SPRI use of their lecture hall facilities when required. Be warned that car parking at SPRI is not available. It is within sensible walking distance (about 0.5miles) from Cambridge station. Cambridge is also very well served by a Park and Ride bus service.
